LIVES HAVE BEEN TOUCHED BY HIV/AIDS

Dear Friends:

**W**e've faced the challenges of the year 2009 with creativity and determination. In anticipation of a possible decline in funding, we increased the number of fundraising events in 2009 from nine to thirty-one. I want to thank our Board of Directors for their hard work in reaching this monumental goal. We've also faced the challenge of finding a new home for our camp session and weekend retreats. Our Teen Life Skills Retreat was held at Camp NorthBay in May and the teens enjoyed kayaking in the Chesapeake Bay and riding the zip line course. Our transition to the Westtown School is going smoothly and we are looking forward to holding our 2010 summer camp session there in August.

2009-2010 News and Events:

- Members of our Teen Speaker's Bureau have shared their stories with **thirty-four** middle schools, high schools, universities and community groups throughout the year, reaching over **3,000** people.
- On May 1<sup>st</sup>, "Tiny Tears" was released nation wide on over 40 cable companies ("on demand")
- June 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & July 7<sup>th</sup>: New Counselor Training
- August 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>: Counselor Training
- Fifteen of our new counselors were previously campers and I look forward to working with them as colleagues during the camp session.
- August 15<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>: CAMP WEEK AT WESTTOWN SCHOOL.
- September 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>: Teen Leadership Retreat at Camp NorthBay
- October: Haunted House Fundraising Event at Boomers Family Fun Center

One of the most frequent questions we receive about Camp Dreamcatcher® is whether HIV/AIDS is still an issue or problem in the United States. The answer is yes and unfortunately the need for our programs grows every year. Twenty-five of the children attending the session are "new" campers and that number may grow as we move closer to the camp week. Half of the children attending the camp session in 2010 are HIV/AIDS infected and the remaining children have lost a loved one to AIDS or have an HIV/AIDS infected family member. As of late June, we have received 135 camper applications and we will reach our goal of 150 campers soon. It warms my heart to know that as the need for our services grows, the number of financial and in-kind donors increases as well. Thanks to you, we have been able to increase the number of children served by Camp Dreamcatcher®.
